Portraits of the West: Picturing Utopia

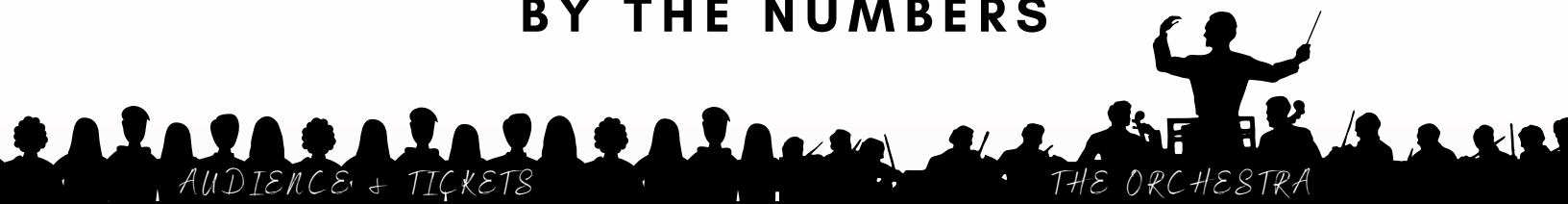


Latinx Celebration

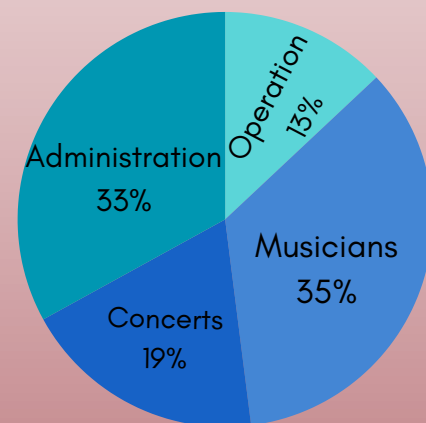
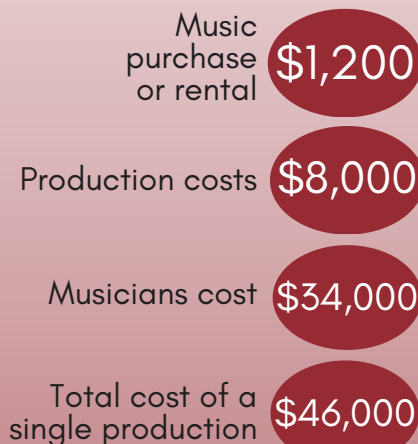
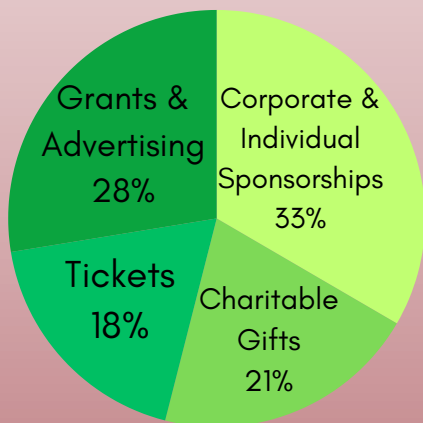
